The municipal elections will be held on November 3, 2009 in the towns of Beaufort, Bogue, Cape Carteret, Cedar Point, Emerald Isle, Indian Beach, Morehead City, Newport, Peletier, and Pine Knoll Shores, North Carolina to vote on the following seats:

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. As designated by GS 163.166.4(a), buffer zones shall be set by county board of elections at 50 feet from the entrance to the voting place. Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing and received in the Carteret County Board of Elections office by 5:00 p.m. on October 27, 2009. Absentee voting begins on September 14, 2009 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on November 2, 2009. The Board of Elections will meet at 3PM on October 13, October 20, October 27, November 2, 2009 and other times as may be necessary for the purpose of approving absentee ballot applications.

One-stop voting will be held in the Board of Elections office located at 1702 Live Oak Street, Suite 200, Beaufort, NC and at Western Park Community Center, 275 Old Hwy. 58, Cedar Point, NC beginning October 15, 2009 and ending October 31, 2009. One-stop voting hours are Monday – Friday from 8 AM – 5 PM with one Saturday of October 31, 2009 from 8 AM – 1 PM. Canvass Day will be held at 11 AM in the Carteret County Board of Elections Office in Beaufort, NC on November 10, 2009.

All residents of the towns of Beaufort, Bogue, Cape Carteret, Cedar Point, Emerald Isle, Indian Beach, Morehead City, Newport, Peletier, and Pine Knoll Shores who are registered to vote with the Carteret County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Voters who are previously registered need not re-register for this election. Those residents of the above municipalities who are not registered to vote must register on or before October 9, 2009 in order to be eligible to vote in this election. Any voter who has moved since the last election must notify the Board of Elections in writing by October 9, 2009. A person may register at the Board of Elections Office at 1702 Live Oak Street, Suite 200, Beaufort, NC or may register by mail.
