

**Resolution of the Carteret County Board of Elections  
Concerning the Temporary Closing of Certain  
Polling Sites during the November 3, 2009 Municipal Elections**

**WHEREAS**, The Carteret County Board of Elections met on May 6, 2009 and voted unanimously to close the Newport #2 , Wildwood and North River polling sites during the November 3, 2009 Municipal Elections; and

**WHEREAS**, voters residing in these precincts, who are eligible to vote during the municipal elections, will be contacted by the Board of Elections via mail and directed to a polling site adjacent to the residence polling site. Voters residing in Newport #2 and Wildwood, who are eligible to vote in the Newport Municipal Election, will be directed to the Newport #1 polling site while voters residing in the Wildwood precinct, who are eligible to vote in the Morehead City Municipal Election, will be directed to the Morehead #4 polling site; voters residing in the North River precinct, who are eligible to vote in the Beaufort Municipal Election, will be directed to the Beaufort #2 precinct; and

**WHEREAS**, The Carteret County Board of Elections will provide adequate notice at least 45 days prior to the next election by advertisement in a newspaper having general circulation in the county, by posting a copy of the resolution at the courthouse door and at the office of the county board of elections, and by mailing a copy of the resolution to the chairman of every political party in the county.

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED** that Newport #2, Wildwood and North River polling sites will not be open during the November 3, 2009 Municipal Elections.

**ADOPTED**, this the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2009.
