

Notice of Municipal Election
Atlantic Beach, North Carolina

A municipal election will be held on October 11, 2011 in the Town of Atlantic Beach, North Carolina to vote on the mayor's seat and five town commissioner seats. Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. As designated by GS 163.166.4(a), buffer zones shall be set by county board of elections at 50 feet from the entrance to the voting place. Poll workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with yellow campaign electioneering tape. The polling place will be located at:

- *Atlantic Beach Town Hall, 125 W. Fort Macon Rd., Atlantic Beach, NC*

Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing and received in the Carteret County Board of Elections office by 5:00 p.m. on October 4, 2011. Absentee voting begins on September 12, 2011 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on October 4, 2011. The Board of Elections will meet at 3PM on September 20; September 27; October 4; and October 10, 2011 and other times as may be necessary for the purpose of approving absentee ballot applications.

One-stop voting will be held in the Board of Elections office located at 1702 Live Oak Street, Suite 200, Beaufort, NC beginning September 22, 2011 and ending October 7, 2011. One-stop voting hours are Monday – Friday from 8 AM – 5 PM with one Saturday of October 8, 2011 from 8 AM – 1 PM. Canvass Day will be held at 11 AM in the Carteret County Board of Elections Office in Beaufort, NC on October 18, 2011.

All residents of the Town of Atlantic Beach who are registered to vote with the Carteret County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Voters who are previously registered need not re-register for this election. Those residents of the Town of Atlantic Beach who are not registered to vote must register on or before September 16, 2011 to be eligible to vote in this election. Any voter who has moved since the last election must notify the Board of Elections in writing by September 16, 2011. A person may register at the Board of Elections Office at 1702 Live Oak Street, Suite 200, Beaufort, NC or may register by mail.
