

Notice of Municipal Election  
Atlantic Beach, North Carolina

A municipal election will be held on October 9, 2007 in the Town of Atlantic Beach, North Carolina to vote on the mayor's seat and five town commissioner seats. Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. The polling place will be located at:

- *Atlantic Beach Town Hall, 125 W. Fort Macon Rd., Atlantic Beach, NC*

Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing and received in the Carteret County Board of Elections office by 5:00 p.m. on October 2, 2007. Absentee voting begins on September 7, 2007 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on October 8, 2007. The Board of Elections will meet on September 18; September 25; October 2; and October 8, 2007 and other times as may be necessary for the purpose of approving absentee ballot applications.

One-stop voting will be held in the Board of Elections office located at 1510 Live Oak St., Beaufort, NC beginning September 20, 2007 and ending October 6, 2007. One-stop voting hours are Monday – Friday from 8 AM – 5 PM with one Saturday of October 6, 2007 from 8 AM – 1 PM. Canvass Day will be held at 11 AM in the Carteret County Board of Elections Office in Beaufort, NC on October 16, 2007.

All residents of the Town of Atlantic Beach who are registered to vote with the Carteret County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Voters who are previously registered need not re-register for this election. Those residents of the Town of Atlantic Beach who are not registered to vote must register on or before September 14, 2007 to be eligible to vote in this election. Any voter who has moved since the last election must notify the Board of Elections in writing by September 14, 2007. A person may register at the Board of Elections Office at 1510 Live Oak Street, Beaufort, NC or may register by mail.
