Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing and received in the Carteret County Board of Elections office by 5:00 p.m. on October 30, 2007. Absentee voting begins on October 5, 2007 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on November 5, 2007. The Board of Elections will meet on October 16, October 23, October 30, November 5, 2007 and other times as may be necessary for the purpose of approving absentee ballot applications.

One-stop voting will be held in the Board of Elections office located at 1510 Live Oak Street, Beaufort, NC and at Western Park Community Center, 275 Old Hwy.

58, Cedar Point, NC beginning October 18, 2007 and ending November 3, 2007. One-stop voting hours are Monday – Friday from 8 AM – 5 PM with one Saturday of November 3, 2007 from 8 AM – 1 PM. Canvass Day will be held at 11 AM in the Carteret County Board of Elections Office in Beaufort, NC on November 13, 2007.

All residents of the towns of Beaufort, Bogue, Cape Carteret, Cedar Point, Emerald Isle, Indian Beach, Morehead City, Newport, Peletier, and Pine Knoll Shores who are registered to vote with the Carteret County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Voters who are previously registered need not re-register for this election. Those residents of the above municipalities who are not registered to vote must register on or before October 12, 2007 in order to be eligible to vote in this election. Any voter who has moved since the last election must notify the Board of Elections in writing by October 12, 2007. A person may register at the Board of Elections Office at 1510 Live Oak St., Beaufort, NC or may register by mail.
