

NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION
CARTERET COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

A general election will be held on November 4, 2008; in Carteret County, North Carolina for the following offices: President and Vice President of the United States; US Senate; US House of Representatives, District 3; Governor; Lieutenant Governor; Attorney General; Auditor; Commissioner of Agriculture; Commissioner of Insurance; Commissioner of Labor; Secretary of State; Superintendent of Public Instruction; Treasurer; NC State Senate, District 2; NC House of Representatives, District 13; County Commissioner, Districts 3, 4, and 5; Supreme Court Associate Justice; Court of Appeals Judges; District Court Judges, District 3B; Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor.

All 34 polls will be open from 6:30 AM until 7:30 PM. Buffer zones as designated by G.S. 163-166.4(a) shall be 50 feet from the entrance to the voting place.

Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing and received in the Carteret County Board of Elections office by 5:00 PM on October 28, 2008. Mail-out absentees must be received by the Carteret County Board of Elections office by 5:00 PM on November 3, 2008. One-stop voting will be held at the Western Park Community Center; 275 Old Hwy 58, Cedar Point, NC and at Bridgeway Church of Nazarene, 100 Lockhart Lane, Beaufort, NC beginning October 16, 2008 and ending November 4, 2008. One-stop hours are Monday – Friday from 8 AM to 5 PM and on Saturday, November 1 from 8 AM to 1 PM. An additional one-stop location with reduced hours will be open at the Crystal Coast Church of Nazarene, 4311 Country Club Rd., Morehead City beginning October 16, 2008 and ending October 31, 2008. The hours for this location will be Monday – Friday from 8 AM to 5 PM only with no Saturday hours. The Board of Elections Office will be available for one-stop voting on Saturday, November 1 only from 8 AM – 1 PM.

Canvass will be held in the Board of Elections office on Friday, November 14, 2008 at 11 AM.
