

Notice of Primary Election
Carteret County, North Carolina

A Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, May 4, 2010, in the County of Carteret, North Carolina to vote on the offices of US Senate, US House of Representatives, NC House of Representatives District 13, Sheriff, County Commissioner District 1, Board of Education Districts 1, 3, 5, and 6 and Court of Appeals Judge. Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.

Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing and received in the Carteret County Board of Elections office by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 27, 2010. Absentee voting by-mail begins on March 15, 2010 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, May 3, 2010.

One-stop voting will be held in the Board of Elections Office, 1702 Live Oak Street, Beaufort, NC and at the Western Park Community Center, 275 Old Hwy 58, Cedar Point, NC beginning Thursday, April 15, 2010 at 8 AM and ending Saturday, May 1, 2010 at 1 PM. One-stop voting hours are Monday – Friday from 8 AM – 5 PM and on final Saturday from 8 AM – 1 PM. Canvass Day will be held at 11 AM in the Board of Elections office in Beaufort, NC on Tuesday, May 11, 2010.
