

NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION
CARTERET COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

A general election will be held on November 2, 2010; in Carteret County, North Carolina for the following offices: US Senate; US House of Representatives, District 3; NC State Senate, District 2; NC House of Representatives, District 13; District Attorney, District 3B; County Commissioner, Districts 1, 2, 3 and 6; Sheriff; Clerk of Superior Court; Register of Deeds; Supreme Court Associate Justice; Court of Appeals Judges; Superior Court Judge, District 3B; Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisor. On the ballot, there will be a vote on a proposed NC Constitutional Amendment providing that no person convicted of a felony may serve as Sheriff.

All 34 polls will be open from 6:30 AM until 7:30 PM. Buffer zones as designated by G.S. 163-166.4(a) shall be 50 feet from the entrance to the voting place.

Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing and received in the Carteret County Board of Elections office by 5:00 PM on October 26, 2010. Mail-out absentees must be received by the Carteret County Board of Elections office by 5:00 PM on November 1, 2010 or postmarked by November 2, 2010 and received not later than 5:00 PM on November 5, 2010. One-stop voting will be held at the Board of Elections Office; 1702 Live Oak Street, Beaufort, NC; Western Park Community Center; 275 Old Hwy 58, Cedar Point, NC, and at the Crystal Coast Church of Nazarene, 4311 Country Club Rd., Morehead City beginning October 14, 2010 and ending October 30, 2010. One-stop hours are Monday – Friday from 8 AM to 5 PM and one final Saturday, October 30th from 8 AM to 1 PM.

Canvass will be held in the Board of Elections office on Friday, November 12, 2010 at 11 AM.
